<Measures to be implemented during the show (planned. as of March 12)>

- Body temperature measurements by thermography devices at all the exhibition entrances

In case body temperature is 37.5C (99.5F) or above, we may reject his/her entry after he/she submits a health check sheet and goes through interview by a doctor or nurse.)

- Signboards to recommend Respiratory Hygiene/Cough Etiquette & Frequent Hand-washing will be put onsite
- Full-time ventilation of exhibition halls by large scale air-conditioning facilities
- Opening doors of seminar rooms all the time for adequate ventilation
- Sterilization of tables and chairs at seminar rooms
- Securing adequate space between seats at seminar rooms
- First-aid room will be set up and a doctor & nurse will be stationed at the venue all time during the show
